Thank you for your interest in our first Embassy Row Tour! We've planned a day packed with cultural information, interactions, and experiences to help children (and adults) learn about what it's like to be a child in other countries.

At each of the five embassies we visit, a representative of that country will give a short presentation about his or her country to help the students gain awareness of what life is like for children in that country. Children will also learn about the purpose of embassies, the role of ambassadors, and related topics. Time is included in the schedule for questions and answers, restroom breaks, and walking time between embassies.

This trip is geared for elementary age children and their parents, although it is open to everyone. Parents not able to attend may designate another registered adult to be responsible for their child(ren), with at least one adult responsible for every five children (use Registration Form #2).
